

OVERVIEW: Flex Assistance Support "FLEX with JUMP"

The Joint Urban Ministries Projects **Flex Assistance Support (FAS)** is an online application.

FAS delivers by mail aid to the home of eligible clients pending availability of resources and/or program space availability. FAS is designed to provide a safe and efficient means to purchase groceries or transportation gas assistance.

NOTE, JUMP has adapted operations to remain open **ONLY** online to ensure service continuity, although limited. We have limitations and can only do what we can within those limitations. Everyone is making adaptations, whether non-profits or the business world. **As such, currently, JUMP is only able to help clients with proof of residency.**



What do eligible FAS clients receive?

If you are determined eligible, you will receive your choice of one of the below by mail in 2-4 days:

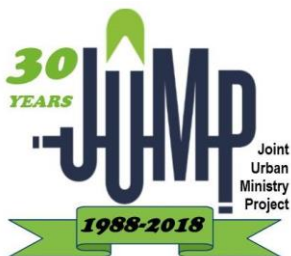
- Hannaford cards \$30
- City Market cards \$30
- Shell Gas card: \$25

Who qualifies "any of the below conditions"?

- Meet Federal poverty income guidelines
- Live in subsidized and/section 8 housing
- Recipient: 3 Squares, Reach Up or SSI/SSDI

How do Clients apply?

The **FAS** form link will be available on our website with instructions how to apply to receive help by mail. Note, all clients must complete and submit the **FAS** form to determine eligibility which depends on availability of resources and/or program space availability.
