OVERVIEW: Flex Assistance Support "FLEX with JUMP"

The Joint Urban Ministries Projects Flex Assistance Support (FAS) is an online application.

FAS delivers by mail aid to the home of eligible clients pending availability of resources and/or program space availability. FAS is designed to provide a safe and efficient means to purchase groceries or transportation gas assistance.

NOTE, JUMP has adapted operations to remain open ONLY online to ensure service continuity, although limited. We have limitations and can only do what we can within those limitations. Everyone is making adaptations, whether non-profits or the business world. *As such, currently, JUMP is only able to help clients with proof of residency.*



What do eligible FAS clients receive?

If you are determined eligible, you will receive your choice of one of the below by mail in 2-4 days:

- Hannaford cards \$30
- City Market cards \$30
- Shell Gas card: \$25

Who qualifies "any of the below conditions"?

- Meet Federal poverty income guidelines
- Live in subsidized and/section 8 housing
- Recipient: 3 Squares, Reach Up or SSI/SSDI

How do Clients apply?

The **FAS** form link will be available on our website with instructions how to apply to receive help by mail. Note, all clients must complete and submit the **FAS** form to determine eligibility which depends on availability of resources and/or program space availability.
